MATT KERSHAW (YLead) Host

STEPH LORENZO (PROJECT FUTURES) FINDING YOUR PASSION & TAKING ACTION

Stephanie will speak about the reality of human trafficking on a worldwide scale and has a refreshing take on how we can combat this issue and become truly empowered individuals with a higher purpose to make this world a better place.



LAURA VIDAL (THE SALVATION ARMY) MODERN DAY SLAVERY IN AUSTRALIA

Laura will speak about her time as a Social Worker. She has been working with and advocating on behalf of people who have experienced human trafficking and modern day slavery in Australia for the last 6 years. In Australia, slaveholders are using people against their will for their own profit or advantage.



LOVE BITES A PROGRAM FROM NAPCAN

Love Bites will focus on healthy and unhealthy relationships in the context of domestic and family violence and sexual assault prevention. Love Bites will explore the attitudes and behaviors that support violence against women as well as the rights and responsibilities in relationships. Through this talk we also aim to deconstruct the myths surrounding domestic violence and sexual assault.



Dominic Greenwood (Batyr) MENTAL HEALTH

Dom has traveled the world, has an incredible group of mates and has a job he loves. He also has to focus on managing his mental health daily. Today he will be talking about how his 'masculinity' fueled his shame about experiencing mental health issues and how tackling the elephant in the room is something he does everyday through his work at Batyr- a for purpose organization that focuses on preventative education in the area of youth mental health.

Batyr engages, educates and empowers the audience to learn from the experiences of others and to reach out to the great services around them.
